Winners of the AIB award in 2009, artistic duo Anne Cleary and Denis Connolly share their time between Ireland and Paris, working principally in Ireland.

Their works revolves around visual perception. How we look at the world and the way we understand it, each of us from our own singular perspective, is central to what we are as human beings. Recent projects include a series of outdoor scultural artworks for the <a href="Marconi Radio Station">Marconi Radio Station</a> in Clifden, a series of <a href="polished aluminium helmets">polished aluminium helmets</a> that transfor vision, and a <a href="Building Peace through the Arts project">Building Peace through the Arts project</a> at Ballyjamesduff in County Cavan. Cleary and Connolly also work internationally, recent projects include: a project on <a href="Art and Neuroscience">Art and Neuroscience</a> with David Byrne in New York; <a href="Self Perceptions">Self Perceptions</a> at the Tate Modern in London; and <a href="Less than Thirteen">Less than Thirteen</a>, a commission from the Barbican Centre in London exploring the movements of conductor Sir Simon Rattle.
